^{*}Please note that a portion of the distribution paid on January 3, 2017 to shareholders of record on December 22, 2016 was deemed to be applicable to the prior tax year for the Company to meet its IRS distribution requirements. As a result, \$0.25 per share was reflected in the shareholder's 2017 tax year 1099-DIV and the balance of \$0.12 was reflected in the 2016 1099-DIV.

** Please note that a portion of the distribution paid on January 3, 2018 to shareholders of record on December 22, 2017 was deemed to be applicable to the 2017 tax year in order for the Company to meet its IRS distribution requirements. As a result, \$0.22 per share was reflected in the shareholder's 2017 tax year 1099-DIV and the balance of \$0.16 will be reflected in their 2018 1099-DIV.

Taxable Income Eligible for Qualified Dividend Income (QDI)

For the 2017 tax year, 37% of the dividends indicated as taxable income to each shareholder on their 1099-DIV are eligible for Qualified Dividend Income (QDI) treatment. Please see your 1099-DIV for the amounts applicable to you.
